1. To read monthly statement of Accounts of receipts and expenditure for the period ending 31st March 1958, together with a detailed statement of capital expenditure and recurring expenditure incurred on school during the period 1st June 1957 to 31st March 1958.

2. To consider the re-appropriation statement, placed on the table as follows:-

To re-appropriate a sum of Rs 2,500/- from one minor lead G-1(a) to another minor lead G 1(b) for the year 1957-58. The excess expenditure under lead G 1(b) was an inevitable payment wide rule 22 of Pakistan Cantonment Account Code 1955.

4. To consider application submitted by Mr. M.A. Kair, Clerk-cum-Typist, praying grant of an allowance for performing the duties of school clerk in addition to his own duties in accordance with rule 49(c) of the Fundamental Rules for/period 01.7.58 to 28.4.58.

5. To consider Annual Administration report of the Dacca Cantonment for the year 1957-58, as required under section 45-A of the Cantonments Act, 1924 (II of 1924).

RESOLUTION: Considered. The report should be submitted to Ministry of Defence.



6. To consider joint representation of Cantonment shop keepers requesting reduction in the rent as follows:-

Shops 1 to 5 from Rs 25/- to Rs 15/- each pm  
Shops 6 to 8 from Rs 10/- to Rs 5/- each p.m.

At present only 4 shops are occupied and the shop keepers are finding it difficult to run their business.
