The proposal is best advantageous to the Board in the sense that the area which is mostly low-lying and where the water stagnates throughout the year shall be developed by the lessees themselves by earth filling which will cost them several lakhs of rupees and the area thus reclaimed shall be a source of permanent income to the Board. Reclamation of this area by way of leasing out was also suggested by the DML&C during his last visit to Dacea. Offer of 6 acres to M/S Atlas E Pak Ltd was made by the Board in Msy 166 and S acres to M/S Ali Autos in June 1966, with the terms of annual rent @ Rs. 2/00 per sq yd and premium @ Rs. 10/00 per sq.yd. Both the above parties conveyed their acceptance in writing. In the meantime ICI (Pokistan) Ltd and Herk Sharp Dohme of Pakistan Ltd. evinced a keen interest in the land. The Board vide their Resolution No-21 dated 31st October 1966 therefore decided to dispose of the land by public auction. Wide publicity was made through two important English Dailies of East Pakistan (Morning News & Pakistan Observer). The particular interested were also informed individually. The ICI representative on hearing the terms of lease withdrew from the contest as according to the economics worked out by him, he could obtain land on freehold terms by paying the same amount. He conveyed his unwillingness in writing. On the day of auction the representative of nork Sharp also withdrew as he was under the impression that the land was to be leased out only on payment of rent of Ru.2/- per squa and that no premium was to be charged. No other person showed any interest in the above Commercial plots whereas there was a very hot contest for the residential plots of Kurmitola Bazar Area,
