1. To read the monthly statement of account of receipts and expenditure for the month of August 1954 and a list of total expenditure incurred during the month together with petrol account as placed on the table.

2. Reference Cantonment Board Resolution No. 3 dated 30.3.54.

As the Cattle pound Moharer has been order^{ed} to deposit the amount in the office as soon as possible, the resolution of Cantonment Board directing him to deposit the amount weekly requires amendment.

RESOLUTION: Resolution No. 3 dated 30.3.54 should be cancelled and replaced by the following:-

"The Cattle Pound Moharer should send the the amount to the Cantonment Board Office as soon as possible, on every working day and should credit to the Cantonment Funds along with other moneys not less than twice a month.

The security of the Cattle pound Moharer should be Rs. 25/- which should be recovered by the monthly instalments of Rs. 5/- with effect from 1st April '54 and deposited in the post office pledged to the Cantonment Executive officer.

As long as the Cattle Pound Moharer holds the charge of Cashier cum Head Clerk of the Cantonment Board, he should deposit security of Rs. 50/- in the post office pledged to the Cantonment Executive Officer in the month of October 1954.

As the Cantonment Board Office is 7 miles away from the Bank, daily remittance to the treasury is not economical as it will cost T.A/D.A to the staff for going every day to the city."

3. To consider the appointment of the Sanitary Inspector, applications as received are placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Mohd ~~Hashnat~~ ^{Wah} Hashnat appears suitable and ~~has been~~ ^{is} appointed as Sanitary Inspector for probation of 6 months from the date he resumes his duty. *If he doesn't join duty, within 6 months, the job should be offered to H. Bayli. BAK*

4. To read the James Finlay & Co Ltd. letter No. ⁷⁴ GM/3 dt 20.9.54- Purchase of Truck for Dacca Cantonment.

RESOLUTION: The truck should be purchased on the price quoted by the Coy. 12. P 12757. ~~As per G.O.~~

The Govt should be asked to contribute for the truck for the current year.

5. To read the Accountant General E.B. letter No. OA/3051 dt. 6.4.54. - Audit of Dacca Cantonment Board for 1951-52 and 1952-53, regarding audit charge of Rs. 392/-

Resolution: The amount/ ^{of Rs. 392/-} deposited in the Treasury is confirmed.

6. To read the Ministry of Defence letter No. 26/141/G/D-5/ICH dt. 24.8.54 - Membership of Museum Association of Pakistan.

RESOLUTION: Read and noted. *As the Cantt Buss is not self supporting, the subscription for this purpose, though desirable, cannot be agreed to.*

7. In pursuance of the provisions of Section 60 of the Cantonments Act, 1924, to consider a proposal to impose a professional tax on all persons practising any of the trades, professions or Callings specified in the list put up before the Board and at the rates mentioned against each of them in the Cantonment of Dacca ~~in Tippera~~.

RESOLUTION: The proposal to impose a professional tax in Dacca Cantonment the rates fixed are approved. In pursuance of Sections 61 & 62 of the Cantonments Act, 1924 the proposal be published for the information of the inhabitants of the Cantonment and objection, if any, be invited.

This proposal includes the tax on hawkers, therefore separate notification for hawkers' tax is not necessary. The hawkers' tax should be 2/8/- a month or 32/- a year. Other rates as mentioned in the draft notification are approved.

8. To consider the revised Budget Estimates 1954-55 prepared within the amount of Grant-in-Aid of Rs. 90000/- vide M of D letter No. 133/7/G/162/D-5/LCH dt. 19.8.54, expected to be sanctioned by the Govt. and placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: The Budget Estimates are approved. It should be submitted to Govt. for early sanction so that ~~abstract~~ *landings* ~~extra~~ urgently required may be started immediately.

The extra staff required as provided in the Budget Estimates under the following Heads are also approved:-

- (i) Head A (2) - One office chowkidar.
- (ii) Head E (6) - Three malis. One for C.E.O's bungalow and two for road side tree planting.
- (iii) Head F (4) - Two sweepers - One for public road and one for group latrine.
- (iv) Head F (9) - 5 sweepers for unit roads.

Proposal for making the post of Cattle Pound Clerk permanent with effect from 1-2-55 in the grade of Rs. 60-4-100 as provided in the Budget Estimates is approved.

9. To consider the purchase of cloth khaki from the quota of Div Headquarters for the uniforms of Cantt. Fund Servants.

RESOLUTION: Three hundred and thirty yards of cloth at the control rate of Rs. 2/1/3 should be purchased through D.O. HQ 14 Div. The quotation of Rs. 7/11/- sanctioned under Govt. Pak. Ministry of Defence letter No. 73/6/4/D-5/47 dated 12/23 July 1954, for the M.F.O's staff, is here by approved by the Cantt. Board, for getting the uniforms stitched from the Tailor master mentioned in the above quoted letter.
