2. To approve payment of Rs. 2,220/- to MES on account of connection charges for Cantonment Modern School and Cantonment Market. Budget provision exists.

## RESOLUTION: Approved.

- 3. To consider application submitted by Mr. T.H. Khan, SDO MEO's Office requesting for an increase in the allowance of Rs. 25/- p.m. paid to him for doing part time work of Cantonment Board.
- RESOLUTION: The Board agrees that an increase in the allowance granted to the SDO for doing part-time work of the Cantonment Board from Rs. 25/- p.m. to Rs. 35/- p.m. is justified. Sanction for the increased rate of allowance may be applied for.
- 4. To consider MEO's letter No. EPC/A/303/63/30 dated 22-5-58 regarding planning of 39.00 acres of land declared as BAZAR area under rule 2(b) of the C.L.A. Rule 1937.

RESOLUTION: This should pend.

5. Reference Cantonment Board Resolution No. 4 dated 25-2-58.

To consider PEME Workshop letter No. 71307 dated 23-5-58 enclosing a bill No. 71307/pay/58 dated 20-5-58 amounting to Rs. 3,658/1/- on account of labour charges and material. A sum of Rs. 10,000/- was sanctioned by the Board under its resolution referred to above out of which the Board have already paid Rs.4,528/12/on account of cost of materials purchased by the Workshop.

8. To consider C.E.O's letter No. CBD/Rul/48/58 dated 12th July
1958 regarding increased grant-in-aid to Cantonment Board to
supplement extra expenditure involved on account of grant of a
allowances to Pakistan Cantonment Servants at Central Government arrates.

RESCLUTION: Considered and approved.

9. To consider quotations for the annual supply of night soil receptacles drum and conservancy stores for the year 1958-59. Quotations were **mkxw** called for from 7 firms out of which only four quotations were received. The quotation of M/S Qaisar Hussain Choudhry is the lowest.

RESOLUTION: Supply of conservancy articles should be made from the cheapest sources viz. M/S Qaisar Hussain Chowdhury except for Night Soil Receptacles and Rubbish Bins for which the supply should be arranged from M/S Allen Berry & Co - the best and cheapest source.

10. To consider G.E's letter No. 4010/1398/E-4 dated 15-7-58 recommending purchase of A/C Pedestal Fan 20" Oscillating at a cost of Rs. 718/- for use in Cantonment Modern School. Budget provision exists.

RESCLUTION: Provision of two ceiling fans be made in the Bhasha room instead of Pedestal Fan which is more costly and is likely to be dangerous for small children.

11. Reference Cantonment Board Resolution No. 5 dated 15-7-55,

To consider preparation of a new assessment list in accordance with section 72 of the Cantonments Act, 1924.

RESCLUTION: The G.E. and the CEO should submit their recommendations regarding the assessment of the Building to the Board.

12. To approve appointment of extra labourers for cleaning wild growth on road sides in 'ant nment area.

RESOLUTION: Ap ointment of labours viz. 8 for 4 days (w.e.f 2.7.5% to 12.7.5%), and 5 labours for one day (on 21-7-58), at Rs. 2/- per day is approved. Employment of extra labours as and when required be also arranged in the interest of sanitation in the Cantonment particularly during the monsock season.

13. To consider deposit of a sum of Rs. 6,00/- with EME Workshop for making swings - see-saw etc. for children's Park. Budget provision exists under head G-1(b).

RESCLUTION : Considered and approved.

14. To consider fixation of monthly rent in respect of Cantonment Building (old canteen) occupied by National Bank of Pakistan from 21st June 1958.

RESCLUTION: This should be taken up by C.E.O. with the Chief

Manager, National Bank of Pakistan and results

reported to the Board.

15. To approve transfer of Cantonment Account & from National Bank of Pakistan City to Dacca Cantonment Branch.

RESOLUTION : Approved.

16. To approve supply of Petrol to Cantonment Vehicles from PWSR Petrol pump Dacca Cantonment at the usual rates.

RESOLUTION : Approved.

17. To note the progress of Cantonment Modern School, Dacca Cantonment on completion of its one year anniversary on 31st May 1958.

RESCLUTION: The Board were happy to note the progress of the school and the self sufficiency it has achieved in meeting its recurring expenditure. After careful consideration of the case regarding present scale of teachers particularly in East Pakistan, the Board recommends that the existing scale of teachers be revised as follows \*-
