1. To read the monthly statement of account of Receipts and Expenditure for the month of April 1954 and list of expenditure incurred during the month together with petrol account as placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: The statement of account is approved and the expenditure of Rs. 25-0-0 for payment of Bills as placed on the table is also approved.

2. To consider Govt. of Pakistan, Ministry of Defence letter No. 29/13/6/D-/L.C.H. dated 24th March 1954, directing to incorporate the correct figures of 1953-54 of Budget, sanctioned under Govt. of Pakistan Ministry of Defence letter No. 29/7/33/D-5/L.C.H dated 27th March 1954.

RESOLUTION: The correct figures of 1953-54 referred to in the letter should be the actual expenditure figures of 1953-54 which are now available. Therefore the Budget would require, to be prepared afresh. This should be done taking into consideration all factors and put up to the Board in the next month.

3. To consider the Accountant General E. Bengal letter No. OA/3051 dt 6.4.54 for payment audit charges of Rs. 392/-, as placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Rs This should be paid up when the Budget for the current year is sanctioned.

4. To consider the Ministry of Defence letter No. 29/7/D-5/LCH dt. 2/5/6/54 about the Grant-in-aid, in reply to this office No CBD/Ben1/46/57 date 24.2.54.

The proposal to the Govt. for grant-in-aid of Rs. *384127/-* together with the Budget for the current year is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION : The Budget for the current year (1954-55) is approved and should be submitted to Government for sanction.

The proposal for the Grant-in-aid for Rs 384127/- is also

approved and should be submitted to Govt.

5. To consider the appointment of a typist (General Clerk). The applications of Ex-service men received through the Employment Exchange are placed on the table. The applications of three civilians are also placed on the table.

RESOLUTION : The Candidates have been interviewed and examined. The civil candidates in this case, can not be considered. Out of the military candidates Mr. M.A. Khair (R.P.N.) appears to be suitable and is appointed on probation for 6 months.

6. To consider the appointment of the Sanitary Inspector. Applications received from the Employment Exchange are placed on the table. The Employment Exchange have stated that they have no Ex-military personnel for the post of the trained Sanitary Inspector and therefore only applications from civilians have been sent by them.

RESOLUTION : The post should be advertised ~~in~~ ^{only} as there are ^{two} applications forwarded by the Exchange. *The Ex-military*

personnel for this post are not available

7. To consider the proposal of buying more receptacles for the current year.

RESOLUTION : In the current year 50 receptacles should be purchased at the approved rate of Rs. 15/- each from M/S A.H. Choudury & Co, Dacca, as already approved by the Board.

8. To consider the report of the Cantonment Executive Officer, Dacca Cantonment that the land for the combined Cemetery, has been taken over by the M.E.O. on 19.6.54.

RESOLUTION : The land should be taken over by the Cantonment Board in anticipation of reclassified from 'A' to 'C'. As soon as the estimates for the covered plat-form etc are sanctioned, this important work go ahead.
